# EMBROIDEREE WALL HANGING INSTRUCTIONS

## CUTTING & ASSEMBLY

### 1. Prep:

- a. Cut center fabric into 9.5" x 14" piece
- b. Cut borders into
  - i. 2 pieces: 3" x 14"
  - ii. 2 pieces: 3" x 14 1/2"
- c. Cut batting to cover center fabric and borders, plus some allowance.

### 2. Assembly:

- a. Sew the two border pieces to the long sides of the center
- b. Sew the remaining two border pieces to the short sides

## HOOPING

### 1. Faintly, mark center on all four sides of the center piece using your 8 point crosshair square.

- a. Line up your crosshair square so that the center piece is against the 9.5" line.
- b. This will help you know the hoop is centered when embroidering.

### 2. Hoop the batting and assembled top piece together.

- a. Use your markings and the registration line on the hoop to ensure the center piece is centered in the hoop.
- b. In this project, you will not be hooping through the backing in this project.
- c. Deb uses a 9"x14" hoop

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## CREATING THE EMBROIDERY DESIGN

1. In your embroidery machine, locate Block 2 Corner Design 2 in your starry nights collection.
  - a. Design is sized to 4"
2. Duplicate this design enough times to fit the space
  - a. You will be arranging this corner design randomly as is pleasing to your eye starting in the upper left corner to ensure you do not exceed your center piece dimensions, 9" x 13".
3. In order to save time, use the monochrome button (if your machine has one) so the machine does not stop each time it stitches out one corner design.
4. In the embroidery mode, center the design.
5. Stitch out the star design

## FONT PLACEMENT & EMBROIDERY

1. Locate the Starry Nights Embroidery font
2. Decide what phrase you want to use for this project. This project is completely customizable.
3. Select the letters you need for your desired phrase.
4. Using grid lines on your machine screen, line up & arrange your letters as is pleasing to your eye.
  - a. Lowercase letters like g & j sit below the line, but will come into the design centered with other letters so you will need to manually set them.
  - b. Once your phrase is completed, rotate & center the design.
5. Stitch out phrase.
